#### 主題と目標

Linguistics is a scientific study of language, i.e., our daily tool. How language works? Are there shared systems across human languages? Does language influence us and our thoughts? ... Don't you want to know more about language, which makes us uniquely human ?

In this course we follow two major goals: 'Get into linguistics' and 'Use (and Improve !) English in various forms.' Namely, students will read book chapters from the textbook published in U.S. and supplement materials to participate in activities and discussions using English.

Students who have taken this class should be able to :

1. Understand basics of general linguistics, e.g., identify patterns for components of language, and cultivate their thoughts on language.
2. Describe their understanding of language and exchange their ideas and opinions in English.

#### 授業計画

Students will read book chapters on the following components of linguistics. Additional readings for discussion will supplement understanding of language in synthesized perspectives.

1. Introduction
  2. Building sounds: Phonetics
  3. Putting Sounds together: Phonology
  4. Building words: Morphology
  5. Creating Sentences: Syntax
  6. Making Sense of Meaning: Semantics
  7. Learning Language: Language Acquisition
  8. Your Brain on Language: Processing Language
